Scriptural Passage

Joshua 3: 1-17 – Read Chapter 3. Where do you see the Israelites experiencing God?

Focus Scripture:

Joshua 3:5 Joshua told the people, “Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do amazing things among you.”

To experience God at work in our lives and in our ministries, to be a part of what He is doing, is something we should all desire, but also something we must _____ pursue.

The three characteristics that Joshua displayed to experience God:

- He **completely committed**
- He faced his **obstacles confidently**
- He waited for **clear direction**

1. Complete Commitment

- a. Joshua completely committed himself to more than “Just Enough”
- b. Joshua was completely committed to “Long-Term Trust”
- c. Joshua was committed to “Believing God for Fulfillment”

2. Confident When Facing Obstacles

- a. Confidence knows that there is no “Unknown Obstacle with God
- b. God’s plan requires that we face our obstacles with confidence
- c. Confidence in facing obstacles demonstrates our Trust in God.

3. Wait for Clear Direction from God
